**TOURNAMENT INFORMATION**

1. The gym doors will open at 7:30am, warm-ups will begin at 8:15am, first matches will start at 8:30am.
2. There will be NO COACHES MEETING, but please check-in at the officials table on the east wall of the gym. Please read this sheet for tournament information. If you have any questions, please contact Joe or a tournament representative when you arrive.
3. All matches will be best 2/3 to 25, with the 3rd set to 15 if necessary. No scoring cap in any set.
4. Warm-ups are 2-4-4 for each match, including playoffs. There will be *NO shared serving*, teams must do their team serving within their 4 minutes of court time. LIBEROS ARE ALLOWED TO SERVE!
5. If you have any questions on how the overhead batting cage is played/ruled, please contact Joe or a tournament representative prior to your first match.
6. Results will be posted on the doors just outside the gym. Pool placing will be decided by match record. Any 2-way ties will be broken by head-to-head results; 3-way ties by set record, then total points. All teams qualify for playoffs, which will begin as soon as possible; please note officiating assignments for playoffs. Medals will be awarded to 1st and 2nd place teams in the gold and to the 1st place team in the bronze.
7. Coaches or certified officials are expected to be the up or down official for pool play, but *are required to be the up official for all playoff matches. This is a Ridgewater College Tournament rule.* Please report to your officiating assignments PROMPTLY and fill out all score sheets COMPLETELY.
8. Please bring your own volleyballs for warm-ups, match volleyballs will be provided. Please do not ball handle anywhere else in the college or let younger kids play with them in the hallway due to low ceilings and sprinkler systems.
9. A concession stand will be available on site from 9am-3pm. These hours may vary.
10. Spectators, *please utilize the bleachers first.* If you bring chairs, please place them near the sides of the center bleacher, or near the officials table along east wall as far away from the playing area as possible. Do not set them in front of the bleachers! You may be asked to move your chairs at anytime by staff or team coaches. We ask for your respectful cooperation.
11. Players and coaches, please keep bags and valuables with you. Clean up "team camps" and bench areas at all times. We appreciate your help with this!
