Pool Play/Warm-ups

Gym opens at 7:15 am. Coaches meeting will be held by concession area at 7:40 am for teams playing/officiating the first match of the day. Other coaches, please check in with site director upon your arrival. Pool play will begin at 8 am. There will be a 10 minute (2-4-4) warm-up for each team's first match only. A 5 minute (1-2-2) warm-up will follow for the remainder of competition. Pool play matches are 2 sets to 25 (27 cap). Balls are not provided for warm-up; please make sure to bring your own.

Playoffs

Playoffs will follow immediately after pool play. The top two teams from each pool will be placed in the Gold Division and the bottom two teams from each pool in the Silver Division. The 5th place spot in the gold division will be determined by comparing the 3rd place teams from each pool. The team with the better win/loss record will take the 5th place spot in the Gold Division while the other team will be placed 1st in the Silver Division. The first round playoffs will be a crossover of pools from pool play. Sets 1 and 2 will be to 25 no cap. If needed, the 3rd and deciding set will be to 15 points, switch sides when the first team reaches 8 points-no cap.

Division/Seed breakdown and placement in playoffs will be decided by:

1. Win/Loss 2. Point Differential 3. Head to Head 4. Coin Flip

Officiating

At the 13/14 level, the coach must be the 1st referee. For the 15/16 division, the coach must be either the 1st or the 2nd referee. The officiating team must provide a first and second referee, scorekeeper, libero tracker, scorebook, and two line judges.
